

# Raising Awareness on Human Rights in Youth Sports: The Role of Sport Organisations and Educational Institutions

## Background

The Council of Europe's Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS) is at the forefront in promoting human rights in sport. The <u>European Sports Charter</u> and many other <u>texts prepared</u> by EPAS and adopted by the Committee of Ministers aim at protecting and enhancing human rights in sport.

Through conferences and seminars such as the seminar on Human Rights in sport or the diversity conferences, EPAS offers the opportunity for stakeholders to discuss topical and specific human rights issues. It provides a platform to exchange information and share good practices.

The promotion of human rights also is a priority topic for the EPAS Consultative Committee (CC) currently consisting of <u>25 sport NGOs</u>. The CC was and is pivotal in providing input to EPAS on these topical issues.

## Workshop

The CC will organise a workshop on "Raising Awareness on the promotion of Human Rights in Sport: The Role of Sport organisations and Educational Institutions" on 19.11.2020 from 16:00 – 17:30 hours streamed via the BlueJeansEvents virtual platform.

#### Objectives

The workshop will explore the role of educational institutions and sport organisations how human rights can be best promoted among youth.

The following questions shall be addressed:

- Which human rights in sport are currently challenged in youth sport?
- Which strategies and methodologies should be pursued/used when addressing human rights in sport with youth?
- Which results do we expect when emphasising a human rights approach in sports coaching?
- How can we educate practitioners to support human rights in sport?

#### Structure and practical arrangements of the workshop

The workshop is scheduled to last 90 minutes with 60 minutes reserved for speakers' interventions, followed by 30 minutes reserved for questions and discussions. As a public workshop, participants will be invited to pose questions through the chat function of the BlueJeansEvents online platform which will be used for the workshop and presented to the speakers by the chair of the workshop.
